

Behaviour

We as a Club will be adhering to Motorsport UK Race with Respect Guidelines. This includes:

- Behaving responsibly.
- Treating everyone with respect regardless of their gender, ethnic or social background, language, religious or other beliefs, disability, sexual identity or status.
- Never engaging in or tolerating offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

We will be operating a Zero Tolerance policy on unruly, intimidating or aggressive behaviour. Anyone acting in this manner may be asked to leave the Event.

Any threats, either physical or verbal to Club Officials who are dealing with incidents in the course of their duties, will lead to automatic exclusion.

Noise

Noise must be kept at a reasonable level at all times to avoid disturbing other campers. To minimise noise overnight:

- Noise in the Camping area should be kept to a minimum after 11pm
- No gatherings to be held within the camping area after 10.30pm
- No music unless in the authorised entertainment area after 10pm
- No engine noise between 10pm and 7am unless for the purpose of returning vehicles to the camping area. Please note that driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol or other substances is prohibited both on public roads and onsite.

Complaints

Can be made in person to the event organiser via rally control. Or can be made via the Club website www.theimpclub.co.uk/feedback/

Any incidents will be dealt with either by the Lead Organiser(s) during the event or discussed by the Club Committee at the 1st Committee meeting after the incident is reported.

NB – in this context a ‘gathering’ is defined as a group of people causing a disturbance to others
